

## ANALYSIS OF INDICATORS OF RURAL, FOREST AND FISHERIES OF THE BUKHARA REGION

The success of economic, social reforms carried out in the country largely depends on the level of development of Agriculture. Because agriculture is an area of social importance, both political and economic, for our country, it fulfills the following function:

- Our country forms a food fund;
- Ensures the independence of our country in the food sector;
- Provides raw materials for the processing industry of agricultural products;
- Provides residents with jobs;

Today, agriculture occupies a significant place in the gross domestic product of our country. As for the indicators of the Bukhara region, the total volume of agricultural, forest and fishing products (services) in January– March 2024 is 4.2 trl. the sum was 103.3% compared to the corresponding period of 2023. The total volume includes agriculture and livestock, hunting and services provided in these areas – 4.1 trl. sum of 103.7%, Forestry – 48.0 billion. sum of 103.8%, fisheries – 21.0 billion. sum of 54.3%. In the Republic, the share of Bukhara region in the agricultural structure was 9.2%.

In January– March 2024, the highest volume of rural, forest and fishing products (services) in the district and urban cross-section was Rs 539 billion in Jondor district and in Bukhara district 512 billion was recorded. When analyzed according to the economic categories of agricultural products produced, it shows that 84.9% of the total volume corresponds to peasant and tomato farms, 9.5% – to farms, 5.6% – to organizations carrying out agricultural activities.

Agriculture in the region in January – March 2024 7.8 thousand tons of vegetables (108.3 percent) were grown.

In the field of livestock in the region in January– March 2024, 52.7 thousand t in live weight by farms of all categories. meat grown is 3.4% more than in 2023, 210.2 thousand t. milk (3.3% more), 89.9 million. while eggs (6.5% more), 167.8,000 shellfish skins (5.0% more) were grown, 796.0 tons of fish (46.6% less than the previous year) were caught during the first quarter of 2024.

In the case of 1 April 2024, large horned cattle reached 1,345.0,000 head while the growth rate was 102.5%, sheep and goats 2,416. 2,000 head growth rate was 103.3%, horses 7,490 head growth rate was 104.9% and poultry 7,145. 8,000 head growth rate was 112.9%.

For information, in January - March 2024, a high growth rate of mainly the following products compared to 2023 was recorded.

This includes: Vegetables reached 108.5 %, eggs 106.5%, blackberries 105.0 and meat 103.4%.

Agricultural development is a complex process involving many stakeholders, including farmers, government agencies, scientific institutions and private sector organizations. Therefore, it is very important to establish a culture of cooperation between these mafiosi.
