The important role of computer technology in language learning.

Nowadays the computer is an effective assistant and integral part of everyone, which allows improving the quality of training and the effectiveness of control. Currently, the use of computers in the educational process is very important. The specifics of computer-information model are personal orientation, forming the basis of both purposeful personality learner, able to act appropriately in a real situation, communicative and socio-cultural orientation. There are several computer educational technologies that are most often used in English classes for solving different problems:

- Use of Internet resources;

Very often the Internet makes it possible to find interesting pupils and teachers of visual material high quality. The resources of the Internet help to make the development of the educational material effective and involve students in independent learning.

- Multimedia presentation Power Point;

Having mastered the Power Point presentation program, the teacher can use the technology of project activity in teaching English in solving any educational problem. At the level of the creative application of knowledge, it is possible to organize the independent design of the student's learning tasks. - Use of computer educational programs; The use of computer programs in teaching English, in no way, hinders the effectiveness, since the teacher can construct a lesson that could most effectively achieve the set learning goal.

Teachers use different methods to teach foreign languages. First one is called grammar translation method in which teachers use different passages to teach various grammatical structures.4 The direct method, also known as the natural approach, is in many ways the opposite of the grammar-translation method. In this classroom, students are supposed to figure out rules for themselves. Students are encouraged to speak at all times to ensure student-centered classrooms. Audiolingual is that language learning requires learning habits. Repetition is the mother of all learning. This methodology emphasizes drill work in order to make answers to questions instinctive and automatic. The method which is called immersion is difficult to achieve in a foreign language classroom, unless you are teaching that foreign language in the country where the language is spoken, and your students are studying all topics in the target language.

Total physical response, or TPR, emphasizes aural comprehension. Students are trained to respond to simple commands: stand up, sit down, close the door, open your book, etc. This first step can later be expanded to storytelling, where students act out actions described in an oral narrative. The communicative approach is the most widely used and most widely accepted approach to classroom-based foreign language teaching today, and in many ways, is a culmination of those approaches and methodologies that appeared before. It emphasizes the learner's ability to communicate various functions, such as asking and answering questions, making requests, describing, narrating and comparing. Task-based learning focuses on the completion of specific tasks through which language is taught and learned. Apart from these above, there are several secondary methods to teach, computer-based teaching, teaching through reading.

There are less accepted methods as well:

- Suggestopedia,
- Community Language Learning,
- Language analysis/awareness, a retrograde approach that concentrates on analyzing language data sets instead of actively using language in the classroom.

Todays' teachers should apply cohesive devices, lexical range, accurate letter formation, narrative skills, dialogue writing, summarizing skills in terms of teaching writing skills. Teachers should be aware of the following reading skills to instill in the minds of their pupils.

- to organize ideas for a narrative
- to ensure the learners have complete understanding of the text
- to give proofreading practice
- to check past tense forms
- to give free practice of past tense and sequencing words
- to give practice in reading for gist
- to set the topic and activate vocabulary
- to give an opportunity to the learners to notice sequencing words.

Whenever teacher enters a class, teacher introduces key themes for the unit, presents a set of proper nouns, review structures from a previous unit. He or she should never forget to remind learners of structures they will need for the activity. Assessing learners' own experiences is an enormous approach to keep the interest renewed till the end of the lesson. By this teachers can stimulate learners' interest in the topic. When teacher gives a text to work with teacher should focus on the layout of a text. A good teacher of foreign languages let her or his students practise the language of giving opinions. And students are allowed to predict the content of a text. When teacher is working with new vocabulary they should practise strategies for dealing with

unfamiliar words. Before that teachers should assess vocabulary knowledge and bring learners' attention to useful new words in the text.

Focusing on a lexical set is an urgently important moment of organizing lessons. After this process teacher should practise using new words from the text. As far as the correction comes, teachers should encourage peer correction. Concentration on grammar can be performed with highlighting some unusual structural patterns. And teacher should introduce a new grammar point. Focusing on grammar in context is a good way rather that explaining everything immediately. Yet here focusing on accuracy is vital aspect. During the lessons teachers should personalize target language by checking comprehension. Teacher come up with several anticipated problems like, learners may say the auxiliary 'do' in the past simple question form, learners will use the past simple instead of the base form in questions. In this case teachers should remember to make instructions suitable for learners' level, increase variety to keep energy levels high, give more encouragement in group work activities.

The personal aim here is that learners will increase the number of verbs they know for holiday activities. Teachers should use of proofreading skills, check the ability to read intensively. By this the capacity of students to have knowledge of layout of a written text, ability to write fluently, awareness of register, use of turn-taking skills, ability to infer attitude from a text, knowledge of functional language can be built with the help of teachers.

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
