THE CONCEPT OF MILITARY EDUCATION AND ITS CONTENT IN UZBEKISTAN

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Abstract. This scientific article describes the formation, development, content and characteristics of the concept of military education. Issues such as the formation of military education in Uzbekistan, the importance of the concept of military education, local and national characteristics are analyzed.

Globalization of the world community makes society a priority for modern tasks that must be solved along with development in all spheres of social life. This process is characterized by high dynamics and interdependence of events. Globalization, which is one of the examples of modern social development, is essentially a process of changing the environment of a person; this process affects the environment, society, and the person himself.

The concept of military education has developed organically with the educational processes of mankind, having deep and broad knowledge, having strong skills in their profession, their knowledge and skills is a focused, comprehensive process that ensures the training of a military specialist who can apply its results in the most extreme situations. Thus, the concept of military education implies the training of personnel for the armed forces and types of troops. As an independent educational field, it first appeared in European countries at the end of the 17th - beginning of the 18th century [1. 180-183].

Military education as an educational concept is a military team (unit) to provide military personnel with military knowledge and skills necessary for their military activities, to master this knowledge, as well as to conduct joint combat operations. is understood as an organized and goal-oriented process of preparation and cooperation of parts and compounds [4, 335].

Since its inception, military education has constantly attracted the attention of scholars and practitioners, representatives of various fields of knowledge, social spheres and government agencies, and many consider it to be one of the controllable factors affecting the future of the army and the state as a whole, or determined a certain direction of development of society, global processes, civilization, military construction.

The need to improve the military education system can be determined by the following factors. Development of a clearly coordinated doctrine (concept). Military education as a decisive factor determining the goals and objectives of the educational policy of the military department;

improvement of military-professional orientation of educational programs of military educational institutions;

provision of professors and teachers of military educational institutions based on the specific characteristics of military service by officers and teachers;

development of the quality of the educational and material base of military educational institutions that does not ensure the achievement of the required quality of officer training based on advanced scientific and technical achievements;

It is known that the scientific institutions aimed at ensuring the military security of our country, the decisions made regarding the further development of the Armed Forces, the scientific justification of the rules of the theory and practice of military art, the modern methodology of military scientific research and the analytical study of military events have their own its activity is improving year by year. Military education in the Republic of Uzbekistan is a system of training personnel for the armed forces, providing primary education to the population. Military education is carried out at 3 levels (primary, higher and academic higher education). Primary military education is carried out in comprehensive schools, secondary special and secondary vocational education institutions, military lyceums, educational institutions of the "Patriot" organization supporting the defense of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Since 1992, the staff structure of all military educational institutions in the territory of our republic has been improved. For example, Tashkent Higher All-Army Command Educational Institution, Chirchik Higher Tank Command-Engineering Educational Institution, Samarkand Higher Automobile Command-Engineering Educational Institution have become multi-disciplinary educational institutions.

The main principles of military education in the Republic of Uzbekistan are as follows:

Scientific

training the troops in the knowledge necessary for war,

conscious and active education of military personnel,

be demonstrative, understandable, structured and clearly consistent,

combination of team and personal approach to military education [4, 335].

The main components of the military education process of cadets in higher military educational institutions are the content, organization and methods of education. The educational content includes the implementation of specific educational goals and is aimed at the formation and development of a set of military qualities in cadets, which are necessary for the successful performance of the military professional duties of the future officer.

Due to the change of modern military education strategy based on modern systems in the conditions of Uzbekistan, new educational and combat tasks were taken into account, and certain works were carried out to improve the state structure of military units and military educational institutions. The system of training and education of personnel, national officer personnel training was created. The training of highly qualified young officer personnel has been started in higher military educational institutions operating in the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Today's military education requires special attention to the level of military-pedagogical knowledge of officers, commanders and educators in training military personnel and military teams, increasing the combat readiness of military units and units [5, 34].

Military educational institutions under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Uzbekistan are the state bodies of the executive power that lead the institutions and carry out administrative management, and ensure the implementation of state policy in the field of defense and military education. Defense The Ministry of Defense was entrusted with the issues of providing troops with modern weapons, military equipment and logistical means, development of international military cooperation, recruitment, including training of reserve personnel for the Armed Forces. In the end, priority directions for the development of the Armed Forces were determined based on the transparency of the decisions made in this area. During this period, special attention was paid to the issue of military personnel training. At the current stage of the Armed Forces reform, a new order of military education was introduced, which directly had a positive effect on the increase in the prestige of military service and the prestige of military personnel in our society, which, in turn, was the basis for the development of defense thinking among the

population. serving as The need for military education in the Republic of Uzbekistan and the organization of educational processes are carried out based on the necessity of not only educational but also military content. In particular, the items included in the basic content of the organization of defense contained in Article 5 of the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Defense", including the need to improve the scientific, scientific-technical, educational base of defense raised [2, 3].

Modernization of military education in the conditions of Uzbekistan and conducting it based on the standards of modern world military education includes a number of principles and approaches. First, to have basic higher, special military vocational education and full military education for five years;

Military education helps the student officer to take a real position in tactical management, creates a basis for learning professional knowledge and serves to ensure social security in military service;

The next approach is to prepare officers for the additional professional education system according to a planned program, such as higher military, operational-tactical or operational-strategic training. Mandatory approach is the retraining or professional retraining in military courses periodically carried out once a year and the mandatory appointment of a new military position. This approach develops a military education system for the continuation and training of military personnel. This is one of the mandatory conditions for successful professional activity and promotion in any military specialty [2].

On September 20, 2021, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan instructed scientific and educational units of higher military educational institutions in the field of military education to organize, control and monitor educational and methodological work. "Defense of the Republic of Uzbekistan" of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, which envisages mutual cooperation with the structural units of the leading educational institutions of the republic in other fields in order to improve the content, forms and technologies of organizing the training of military personnel of foreign countries. Decision No. PQ-5247 of the ministry "On measures to introduce the system of training and education of military personnel of foreign countries in higher military educational institutions" was adopted [3]. On the basis of this regulatory legal document, activities on crosscultural exchange between military personnel of foreign countries and military personnel of the Republic of Uzbekistan, as well as quality cultural and spiritual-educational activities are carried out in a coordinated manner.

In short, the formation and development of the higher level of military education in Uzbekistan has important historical foundations, and today this field is gaining a completely modern look. That is, the number of higher military educational institutions in our country is increasing year by year, the content and structural structure of education is developing on the basis of world standards.

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
