THE INFLUENCE OF THE INTERNET IN THE SPEECH CULTURE OF YOUNG PEOPLE

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Abstract: The purpose of this article is to determine the impact of Internet slang on the culture of speech of the younger generation; to study similar language changes in different periods of the development of society; determine the impact of adolescent slang on language changes in general.

Key words: Internet slang, the speech culture, adolescent slang, young generation, language changes.

Nowadays, the Internet is becoming more and more popular, where different people communicate. Every second person spends most of their time on the Internet, so it is simply impossible not to notice how any language is distorted. Young people have come up with a simpler language for communicating online. All this, undoubtedly, can seriously affect the future of the younger generation, leaving a negative impression on its speech culture.

The most important thing today is that the network language now remains not only in the virtual space, but also appears on television, in various magazines and newspapers. Due to the massive use of this language, there is a drop in the level of literacy, because the new style of communication is very convenient and quickly becomes a habit. It becomes more difficult for people to express their thoughts in a competent, beautiful language.

Slang makes speech more concise, emotionally expressive, the speaker can most fully and freely express his feelings and emotions.

We can conclude that slang is a kind of non-literary speech. This slang is used by almost all teenagers and young people.

In various computer games, people use more and more slang, inventing new words that are convenient for communication. No wonder E.V. Mironov, a famous Russian actor, said: "The Internet is a dangerous thing. Brilliant, but dangerous." Indeed, in the penetration of slang into general use, one can find both pluses and minuses. What are the advantages? The possibility of such informal communication helps young people to assert themselves, to stand out from the background of others, and islang sounds more attractive to them. However, the problems of its distribution are the decrease in the level of literacy and the impoverishment of the vocabulary. This can be easily noticed by opening a random chat on the network.

The result is obvious: a lot of abbreviations, emoticons, grammatical errors, etc. However, adolescents are satisfied with this style of communication.

The researchers note that the fate of slang words and expressions is not the same: some of them take root so much over time that they turn into common speech. Others exist only for a while with their carriers, and then are forgotten even by them. Finally, the third slang words and expressions remain slang for a long time and the life of many generations, they never completely pass into the common language, but at the same time they are not forgotten at all.

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What is network etiquette? These are simple rules that came up with people who communicate a lot with each other via the Internet. Network etiquette is needed so that everyone - both experienced users and beginners - is equally comfortable communicating with each other. These rules of good manners are just wishes. Nobody is going to teach you how to live and limit your freedom. But since we are all a community, following these rules will raise your profile and you will attract attention as a pleasant and interesting conversationalist. How to follow network etiquette? In fact, everything is very simple. Network etiquette - it is the same as usual. Most skirmishes on the Web come from the inability and unwillingness of the participants to hear each other. First of all, try to use common sense. You should not do things that are not encouraged in a civilized society - swearing, inciting ethnic hatred, insulting people, etc. Respect your interlocutors, whoever they introduce themselves to, and then your life on the forum will become easy and enjoyable.

What is Flud? A flood is a stream of messages that carry almost no semantic load. These are messages that could be painlessly deleted (or rather, not written) without any damage to the community. Usually flooding users who, by and large, have nothing to say, but who want to attract attention. They begin to reply to almost every email in the subject, and the answers do not carry any semantic load and usually look like short one-line messages: "Exactly!", "I agree!", "I will subscribe to every word!", "I think so too! ", "Wow!" and so on. Flud should be avoided. It increases the amount of unnecessary information, annoying other users. Emoticons are a favorite way for users to express their emotions in a letter. However, it is worth remembering that an excessive number of emoticons makes it difficult to read the text. To indicate your emotions, it is enough to put one emoticon, well, two - but not twenty.

Try not to make grammatical mistakes- Written literacy is the same as oral politeness. Pause for a minute, re-read your message before sending it, correct random typos - this will be your sign of respect for your interlocutors. Keep in mind that chats and forums have their own "literacy", sometimes not coinciding with the generally accepted literacy. Here, many write "wh?" and not "what", "of course" instead of "naturally", "GM" instead of "game master", etc. So it's just shorter, and, in fact, there is no big trouble in this¹. But still - proofread your messages before sending them, suddenly there will be annoying mistakes that you did not intend to make at all.

Abbreviations: Many "experienced inhabitants of the Internet" actively use strange combinations of letters in their messages: IMHO, lol and something else like that. If you come across something like this, don't be alarmed - these are stable abbreviations that came from the English part of the Internet. And they always mean something:

IMHO (Имхо, IMHO) - "In My Humble Opinion" - "по моему скромному мнению"- "mening kamtarona fikrimcha"

LOL (лол, LOL) - "Laugh Out Loud" - "я громко смеюсь²"- "men baland ovozda kulaman"

If you are a connoisseur of such phrases - do not rush to use them. They may simply not understand you, try to find suitable Russian or Uzbek words, there are a lot of them.

Social networks rather negatively affect the speech of adolescents. And if chats are no longer excluded from our lives, then it would be logical to create a concept of the struggle for the purity at any language. Communicating with each other on the network, it is necessary to observe network etiquette³.

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You need to constantly monitor literacy, check your messages for errors. People should be tactful in communication. Unfortunately, most users use slang in their speech. All this negatively affects the speech culture of adolescents. It is very difficult to imagine what will happen to our speech in a few years: we will not be able to speak beautifully, we will completely stop writing competently and thinking freely. But there is always a way out.

Firstly, each person needs to change himself, increasing the culture of speech and mastering the norms of the language. Secondly, in the virtual space itself, it is already necessary to carry out actions aimed at fostering love for the native language. Illiteracy in today's information society should not be the norm. When a teenager speaks and writes correctly, this characterizes him as a smart, developed, intelligent modern person. If this situation is not corrected now, then the degradation of the entire nation is inevitable.

CONCLUSION

Internet slang is the next stage in the development of the language. The history of slang is especially important. It can be used to trace how society, its culture and standard of living have changed. It is a spoken language, a living language. Slang has existed in the language for a long time and serves as a means of replenishing its vocabulary.

Most of the words of youth slang lose their novelty and brightness over time, give way to other fashionable jargon and are forgotten, and some remain firmly and go into literary speech. Our language is changing, sensitively responding to all the changes taking place in society. This is a regular and natural process.

Internet words are not capable of destroying the language system. They have the right to exist, as they are in demand, especially by young people.

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
